
Forum can be accessed by 2 ways



1) Through the main dropdown bar, under Contact; or


2) Each page has a link to the forum

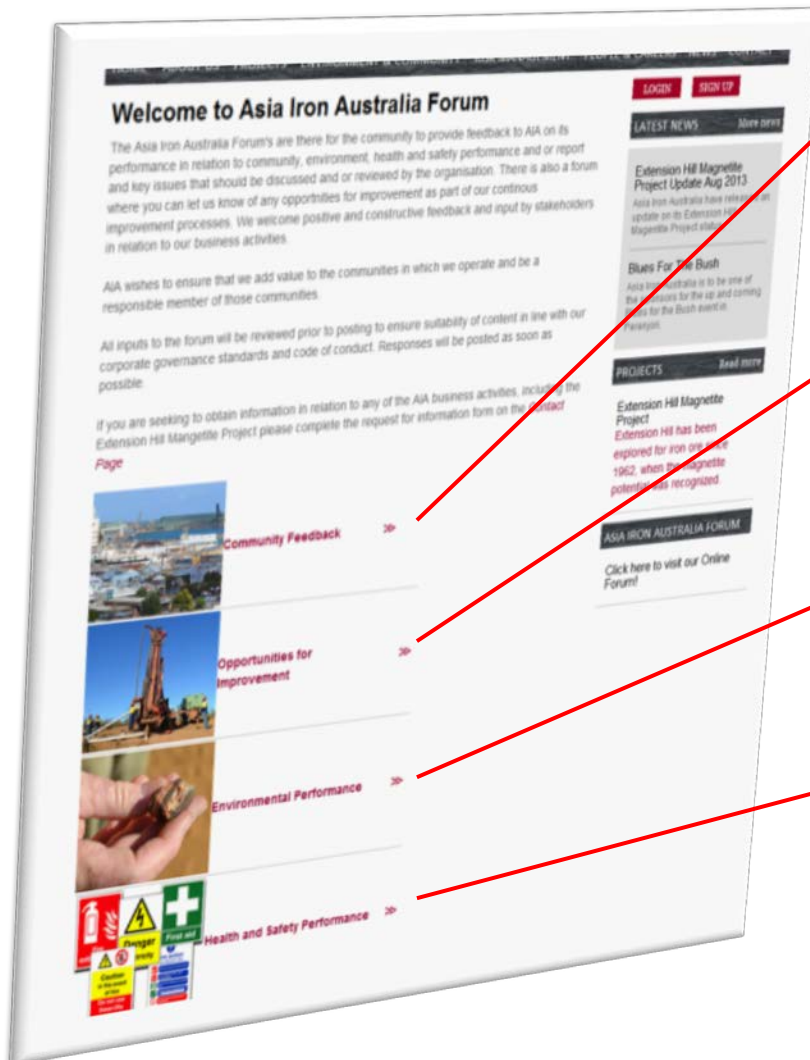
